























World Bank's support to SAIs on SDG Audit



- World Bank collaborates with SAIs in more than 70 countries globally
- Works as a key stakeholder investing promoting independence and effectiveness of SAIs
- Uses INTOSAI approach on SAIs work on SDGs
- Facilitates donor synergies as Donor Chair of INTOSAI Donor Cooperation
- Support Government and SAI approach
 - Most SAIs have sufficient SDG related mandate
 - Can focus on preparedness of countries to achieve SDG targets
 - Implementation of national plans for sustainable development
 - SAI does not take on role of advocacy for SDGs


proportion of population with large household expenditures on health as a share of total household expenditure or income



Financial protection: Data availability issues and high gap



Health's Share of Public Expenditure varying globally



Globally, large variations in health share of public expenditures: ranges from ~1% (e.g., Venezuela) to ~30% (e.g., Costa Rica)


Fiduciary risks a cause of parallel systems and off budget health assistance


Cost of parallel arrangements of four donors USD 1.2 billion (2011-16) – Does this give significantly higher assurance on fiduciary risk?
