Question

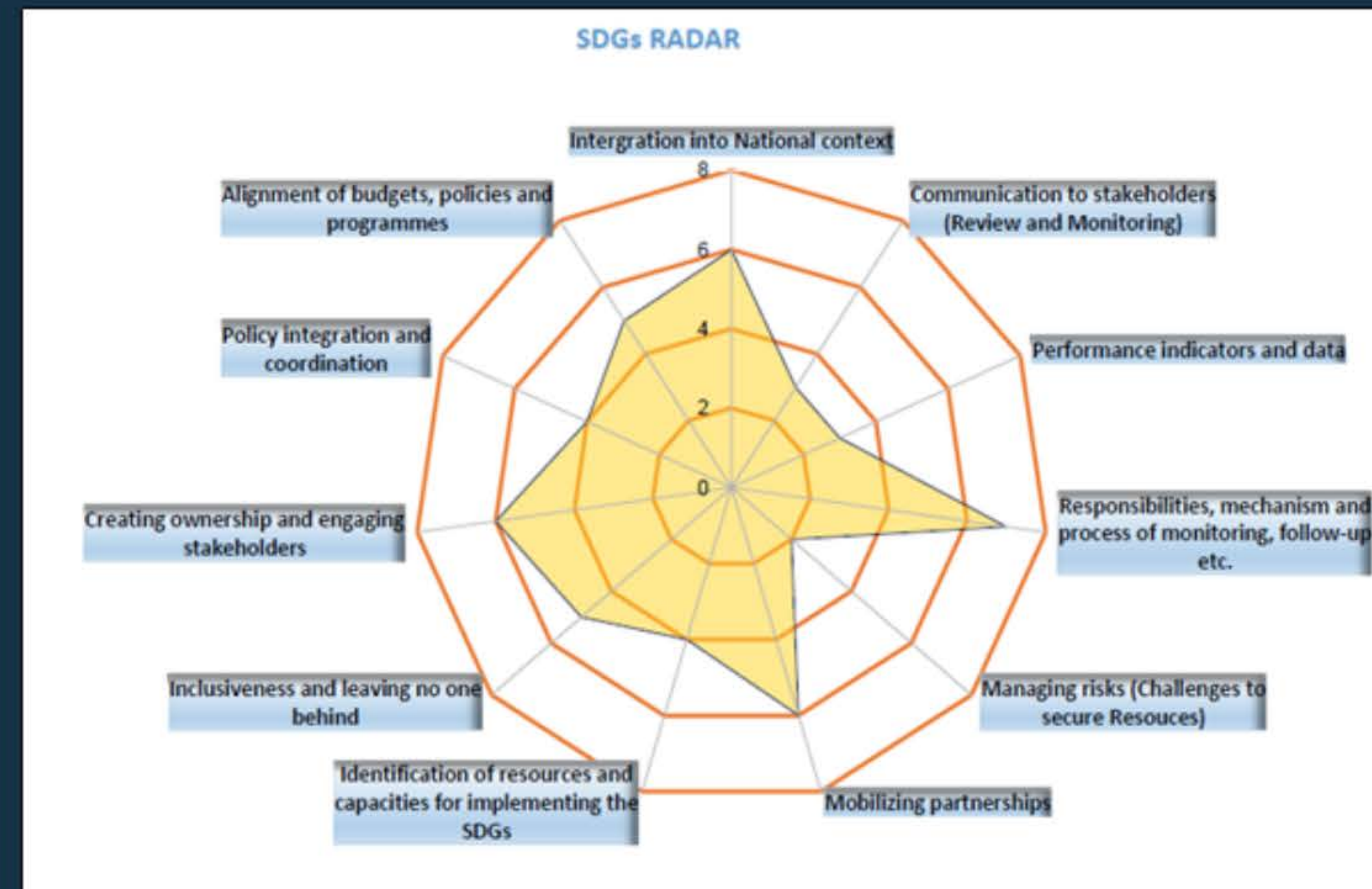
To what extent has the government adapted the 2030 agenda into its national context?

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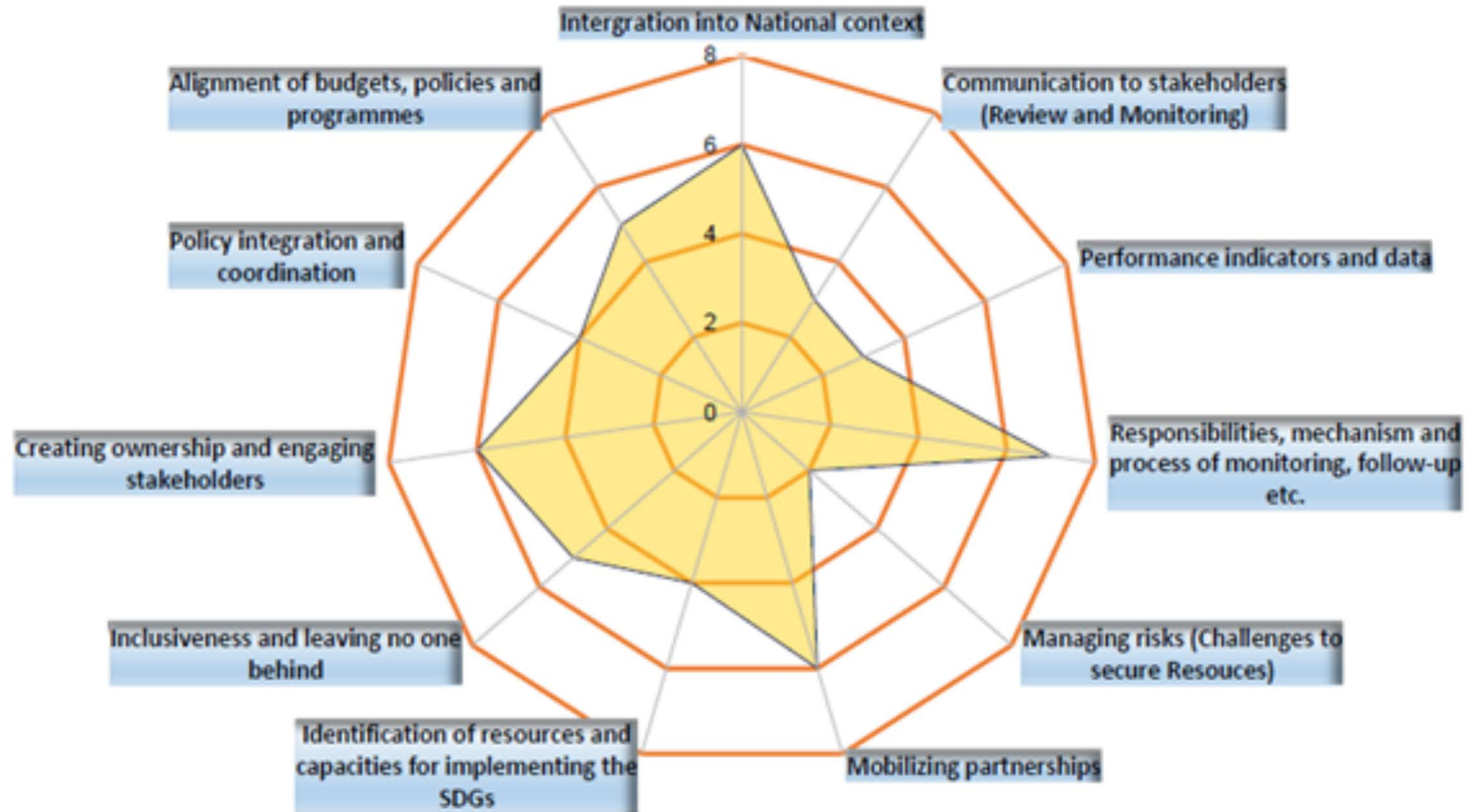

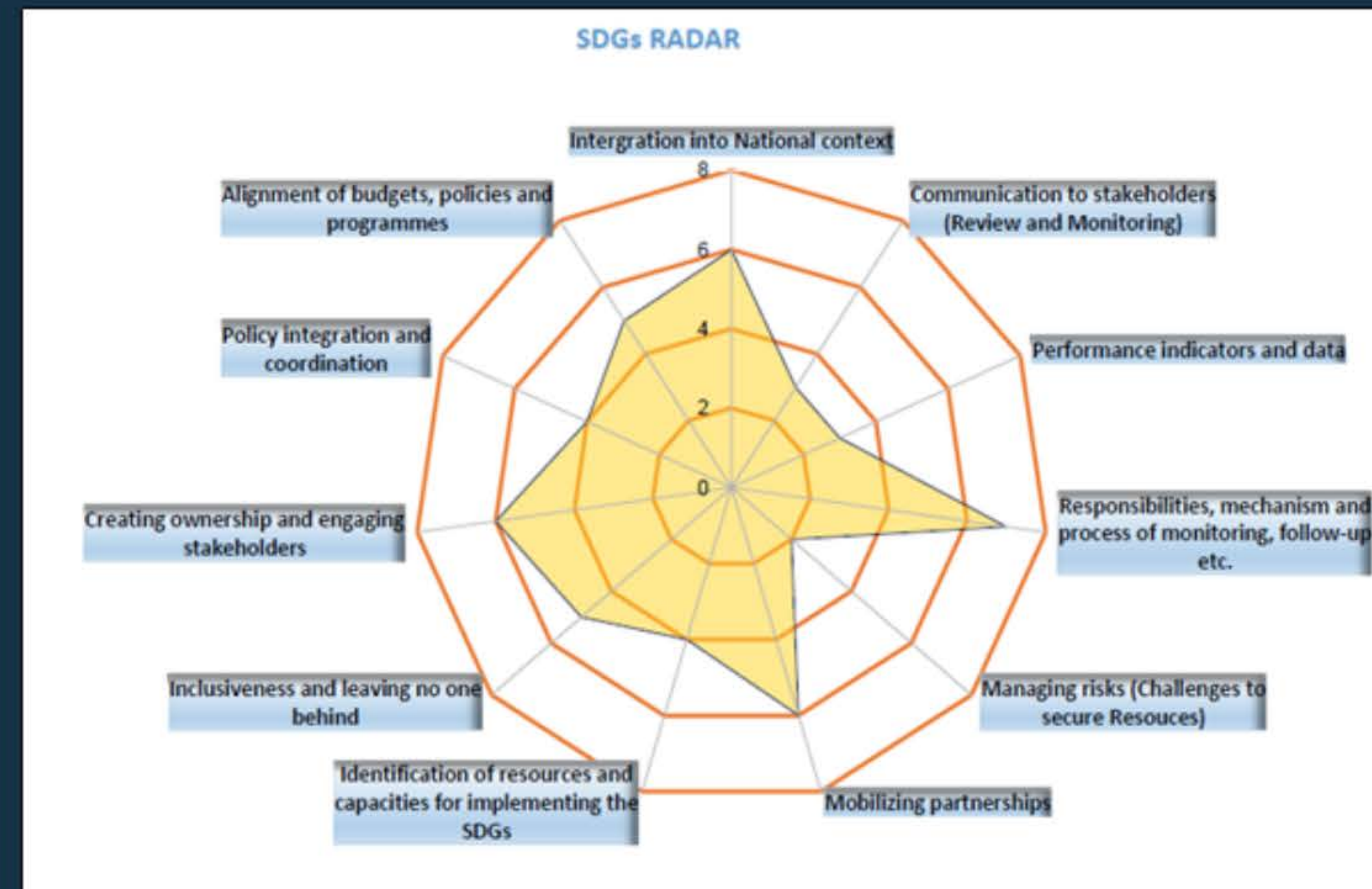

SDGs RADAR



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- Integration of SDGs into national planning strategies, policies and processes
 - Attributions in government regarding 2030 agenda are not clearly defined
 - Line Ministries and agencies working in silos
 - Alignment of budgets, policies and programmes to the SDGs
 - Absence of long term planning framework or planning document
 - Center of government to enable attribution in the government regarding SDGs
 - Efforts are being made towards alignment of the national budget
 - Policy integration and coordination
 - Governance arrangement have been established
 - Ownership and stakeholder engagement
 - Absence of ownership, coordination and accountability among line ministries
 - Delays in finalising communication strategy
 - Strong engagement and participation of social sectors
 - Lack of awareness on agencies related economic and governance cluster
 - Inclusiveness and leaving no one behind
 - Substantial gaps in representative decision making at all levels
 - Existing institutional arrangements support three dimension of sustainable development
 - Conferences and seminars held in collaboration with UNDP emphasised the Agenda 2030 principles


Findings



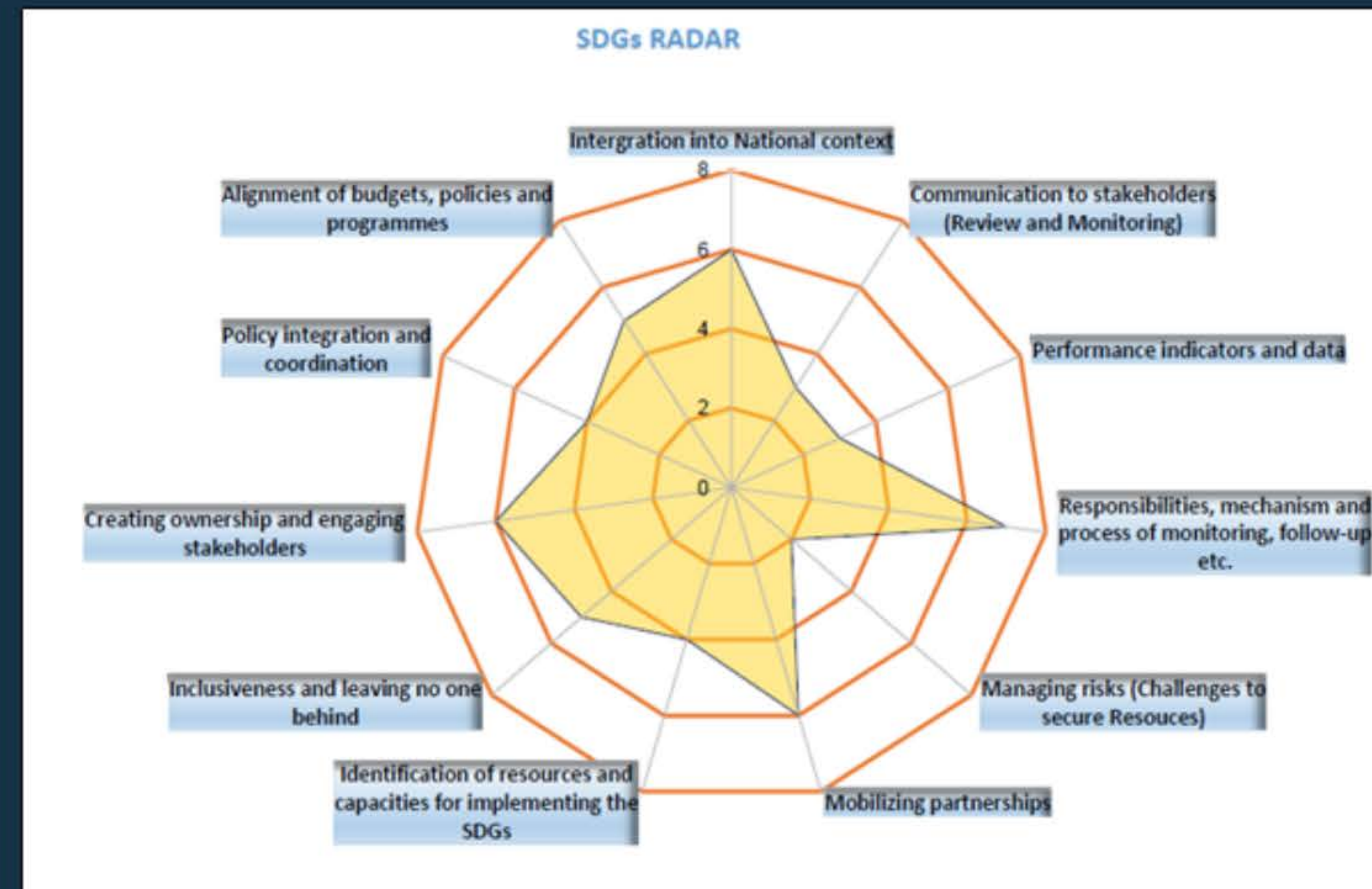
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- Identification of needs and of the required resources and capacities for implementing the SDGs
 - Government has not carried out a gap analysis to evaluate the resources gap
 - Cooperation and partnership opportunities
 - Government has been working towards identifying and creating multi-stakeholder partnerships
 - Securing the resources and capacities needed to implement, monitor and report on government priorities in 2030 agenda
 - Lack of clarity about the extent of resources and capacities secured


Findings



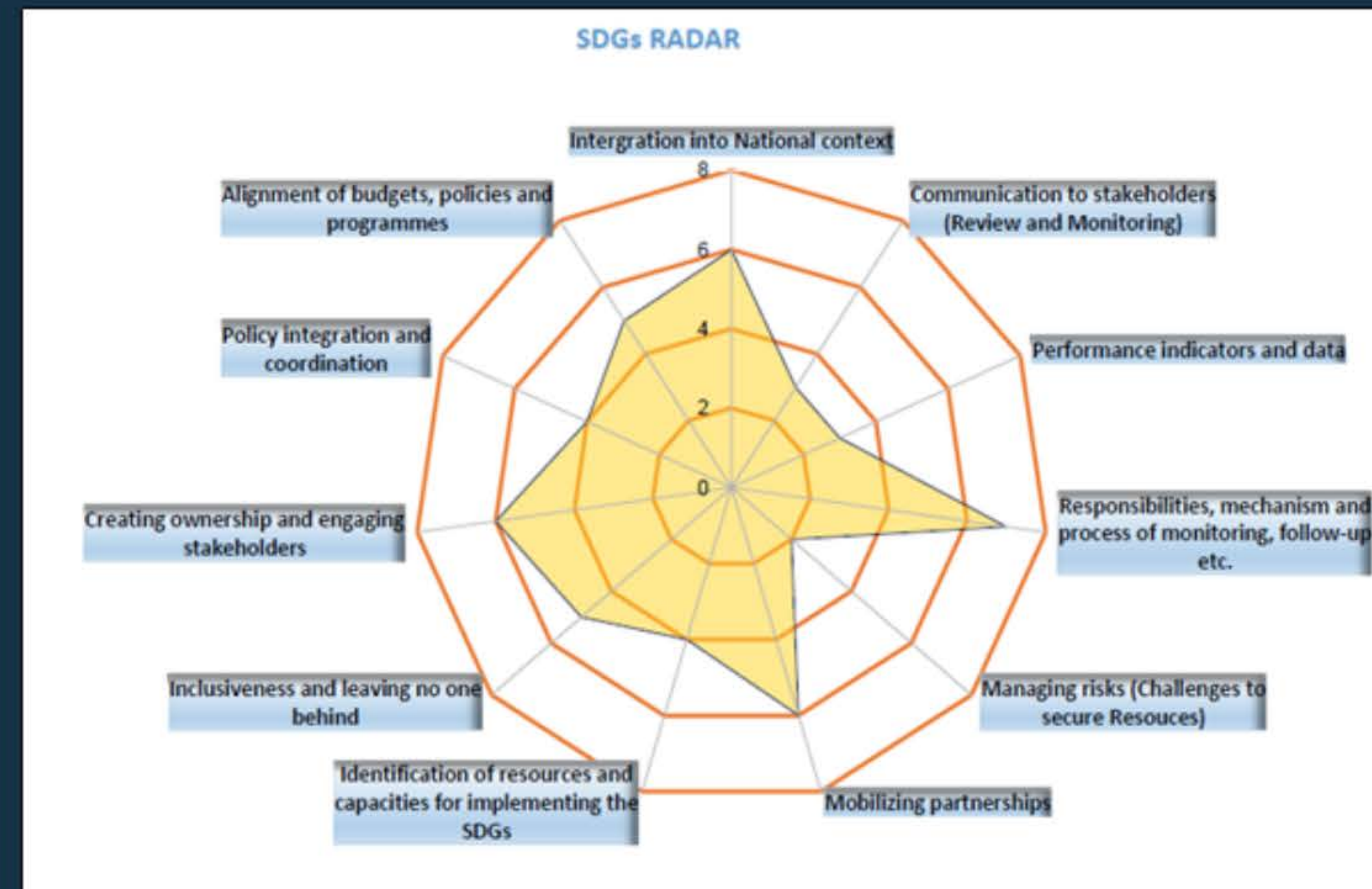
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- Responsibility, mechanism and process for monitoring, follow-up, review and reporting
 - SDG Divion assignment as main lead agency responsible for monitoring, follow-up, review and reporting
 - Data gathering and management across sectors are weak
 - Performance indicators and data
 - Absence of guidelines for monitoring
 - Data quality assurance framework has not been prepared
 - Designing a monitoring, follow-up, review and reporting has not been designed

Findings



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Current engagement

- SDG Goal : 6, Clean water and sanitation
- National Policy: Ensure access to adequate sewerage services that are cost-effective and environment friendly

Future engagement

- SDG Goal : 7 , Affordable and clean energy
- National Policy: Policy 2 of energy sector, expand and develop the renewable energy sector
