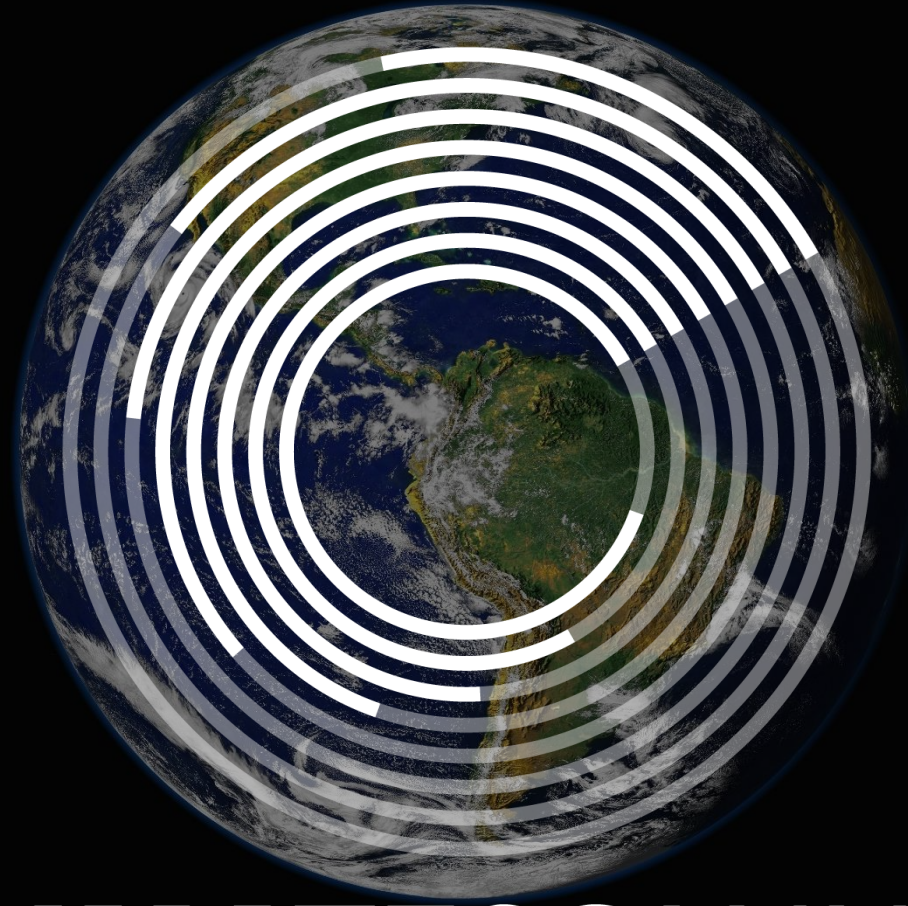

Description of component	Scale of assessment: range 0 – 3		
	Item A	Item B	Item C
<p>This component assesses the existence of mechanisms put in place by government for monitoring the implementation of existing policies and plans, the actions carried out and the results achieved. 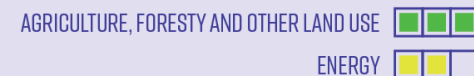
PROGRESS IN EMISSIONS NDC IS POSSIBLE TO BE MET



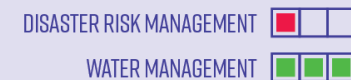

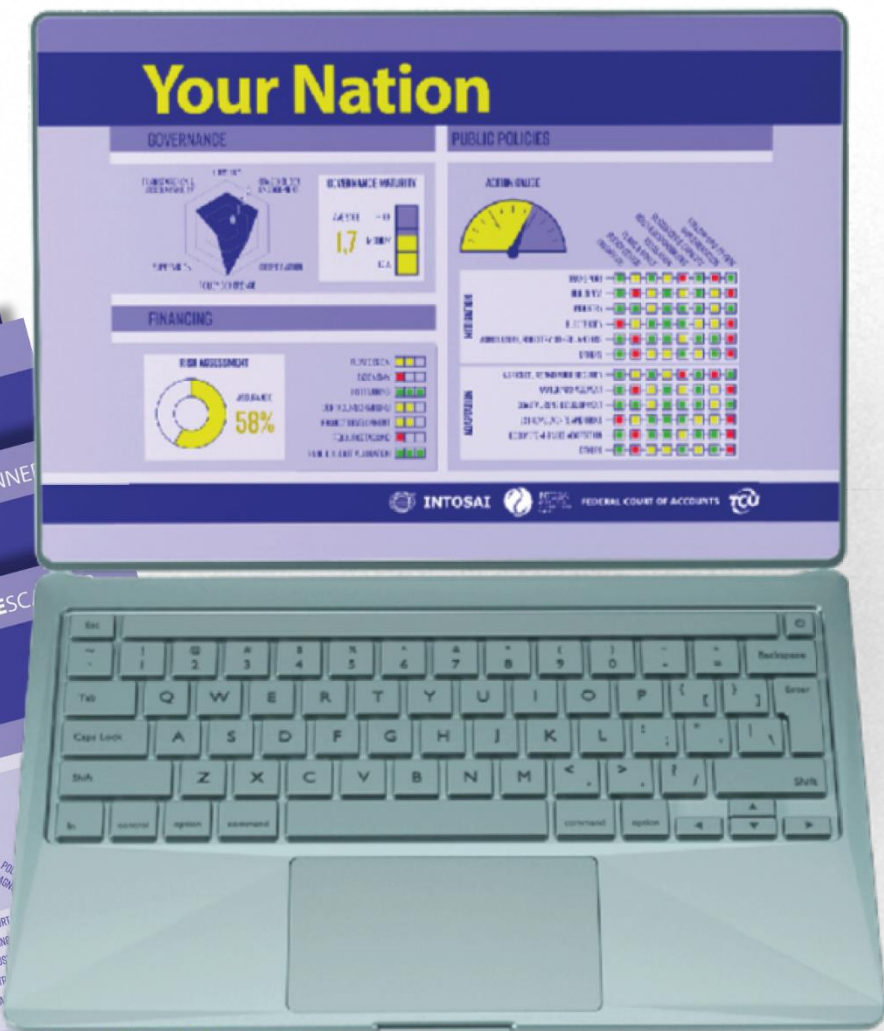

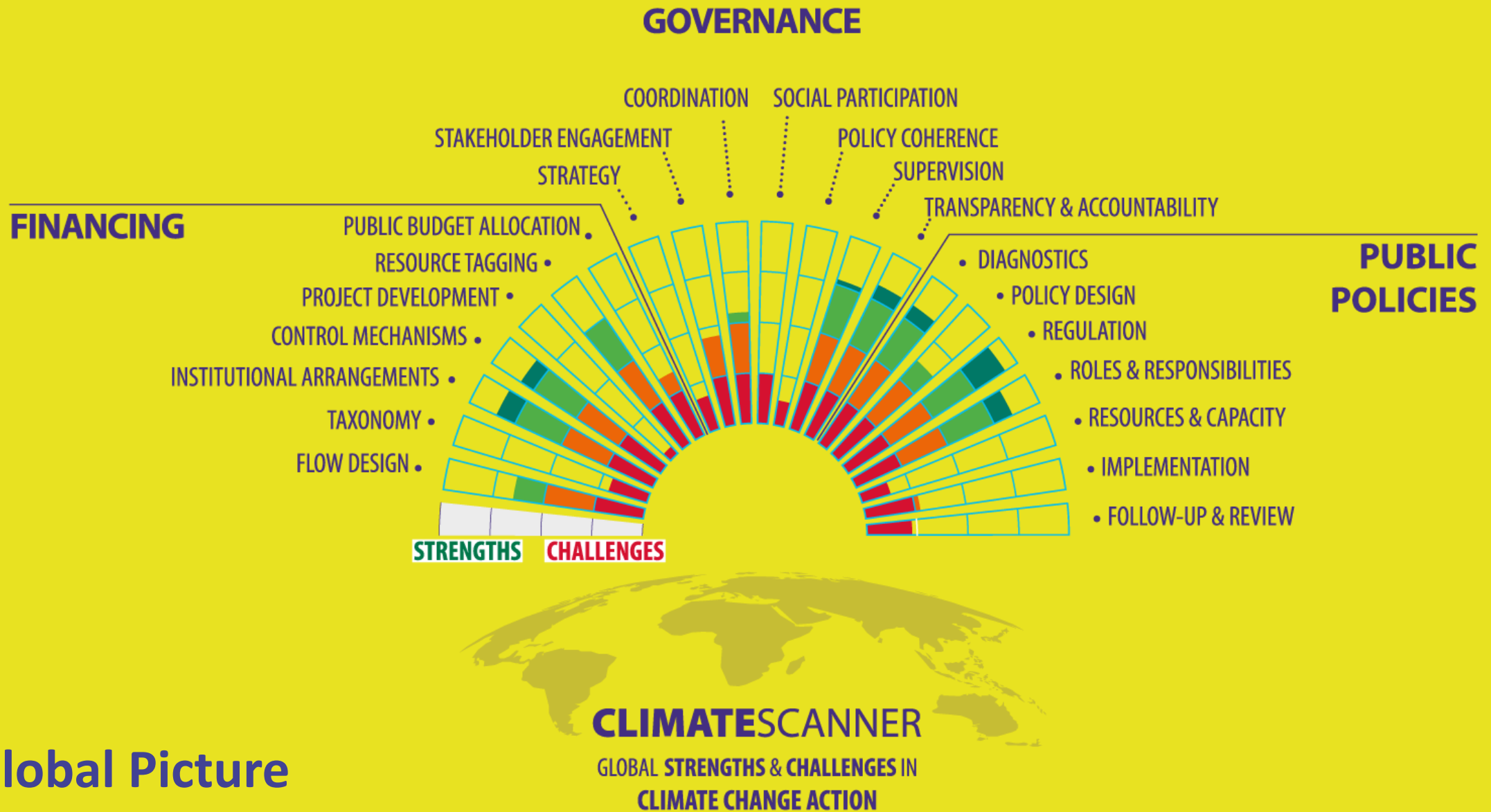
