The New City of Sidi Abdellah?

- ❑ was created in 2009, covering a total area of 7000 ha, 3000 of which can be urbanized.
- ❑ It is located 25km south-west of Algiers, covering an inter-municipal area made up of five municipalities
- ❑ is intended to strengthen the metropolitan urban framework of Algiers
- ❑ approximately **80,000 housing** units and **30,000 jobs**.
- ❑ . Dominant vocation targets **advanced technologies, training** and **university research** and **multimedia**, as well as service function.





Objectives of the Audit

3. What are the different categories of society benefiting from housing in the new city?
4. What are the green spaces created?
5. How green spaces are to be managed and maintained



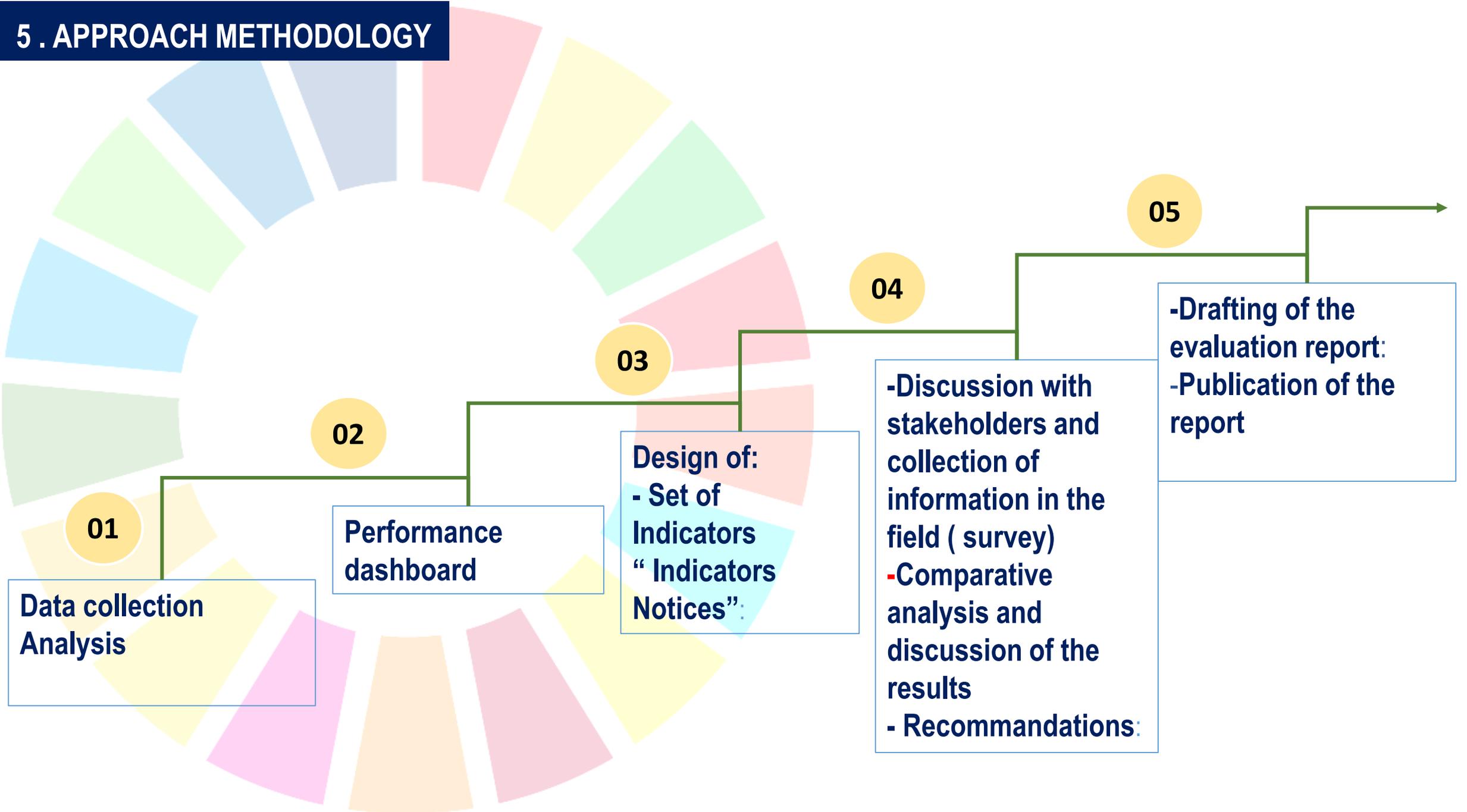

6 . Performance dashboard

1 Governance and Management :

- ❖ Lack of coordination between the establishment of the city of Sidi Abdallah and the governor on the management of the city, in particular the economic aspect

2. Land Planning and Construction

- ❖ Civil society (citizens) was not involved in all stages of master plan preparation related to the city.
- ❖ The design of the residences was not entirely inspired by the architectural models of the Mediterranean.
- ❖ Non-compliance with the project maturation timeline-public facilities.

3. Environnement

- ❖ Slow classification of the green space of the city negatively affects the plan of space management (protection-sustainability).
- ❖ Despite this city has a technological vocation is considered a green city, because the ratio of space per inhabitant (15M2) exceeds the average recommended by WHO World Health Organization (10 - 12)

4. Social and economic dimensions

- ❖ The technological poles require high-qualified workers which is not sufficiently available in the city

recommendations**



On the strategy level

- Establishment of a National Agency for Cities attached to the Prime Ministry, with the missions of design, organization, coordination and monitoring of implementation, prospecting for all new cities.
- Implementation of technical assistance for municipal management, in order to help communities integrate new town projects into their local management policy

Operationally

- Opening a social dialogue with the population and their representatives by establishing mechanisms for consultation and citizen participation.
- Develop training centers for citizens of the city to support activities in the field of technology to provide employment opportunities.
- Giving great importance to the classification of green spaces in order to manage, protect and sustain them.
- Giving more opportunities to the private sector in establishing the city (housing, investment, tourism)
