# Samara Region in details

- The Area is about **53.6** thousand square kilometers.
- Population of the Samara Region is **3 142 200** people, 2.1% of the population of Russia.
- **630** large and medium-sized industrial enterprises
- The basis for the development of the region: automotive industry, aviation and space technology, chemical products, oil refining, metallurgy.
- **446.7 billion rubles** in fixed capital investments were invested in the region economy in 2022.
- the Samara Region is one of the **10 leading regions** in the annual National Rating of the Investment Climate in the Regions of Russia for several years.
- More than **200** investment projects with a total volume of about **1.4 trillion rubles**









### Sustainable Development Agenda in the Samara Region

• <u>In 2017</u> the Ministry of Economic Development, Investments and Trade of the Samara Region developed and approved the Strategy of Socio-economic Development of the Samara Region for the period up to 2030



• <u>In March 2023</u>, the results of the Samara Region's work on the implementation of the Sustainable Development Agenda for the period up to 2030 were reported at the jubilee Tenth Asia-Pacific Forum on Sustainable Development



Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation • <u>On December 6, 2021</u>, the Governor of the Samara Region Dmitry Igorevich Azarov made a report on «The Samara Region participation in the implementation of the 17 United Nation Sustainable Development Goals» in the format of a videoconference at the United Nations Office at Geneva



• Every year «United Nation Samara Model» is held in the region


