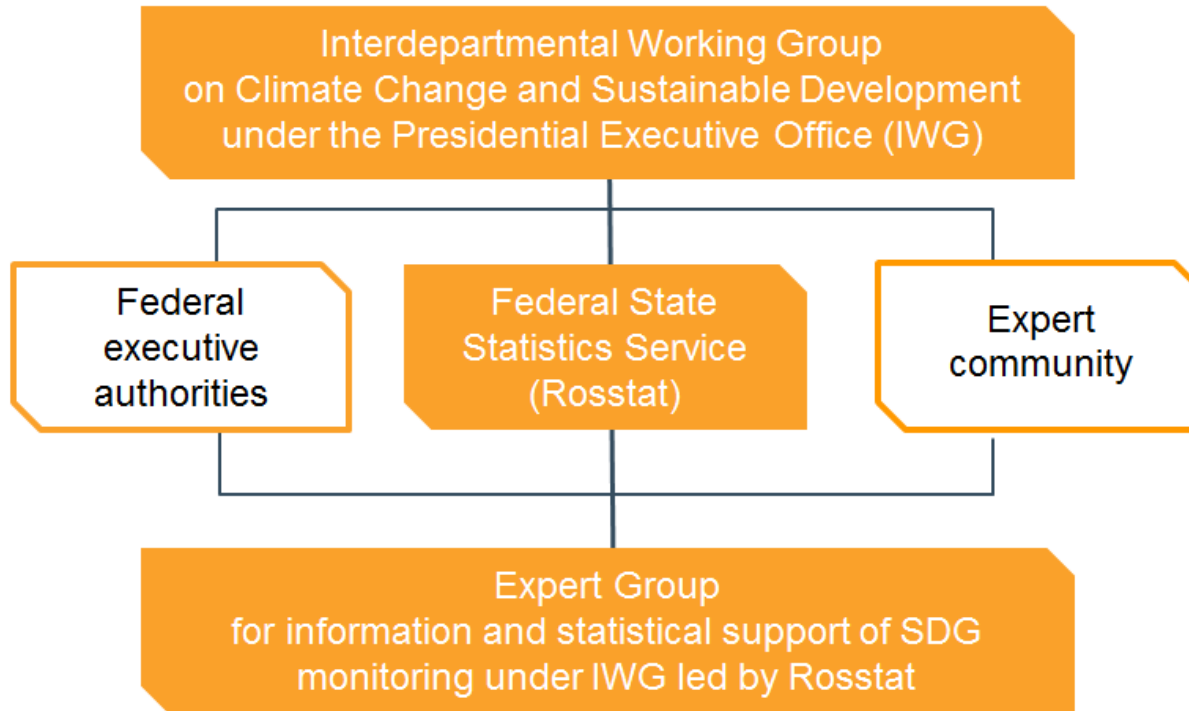




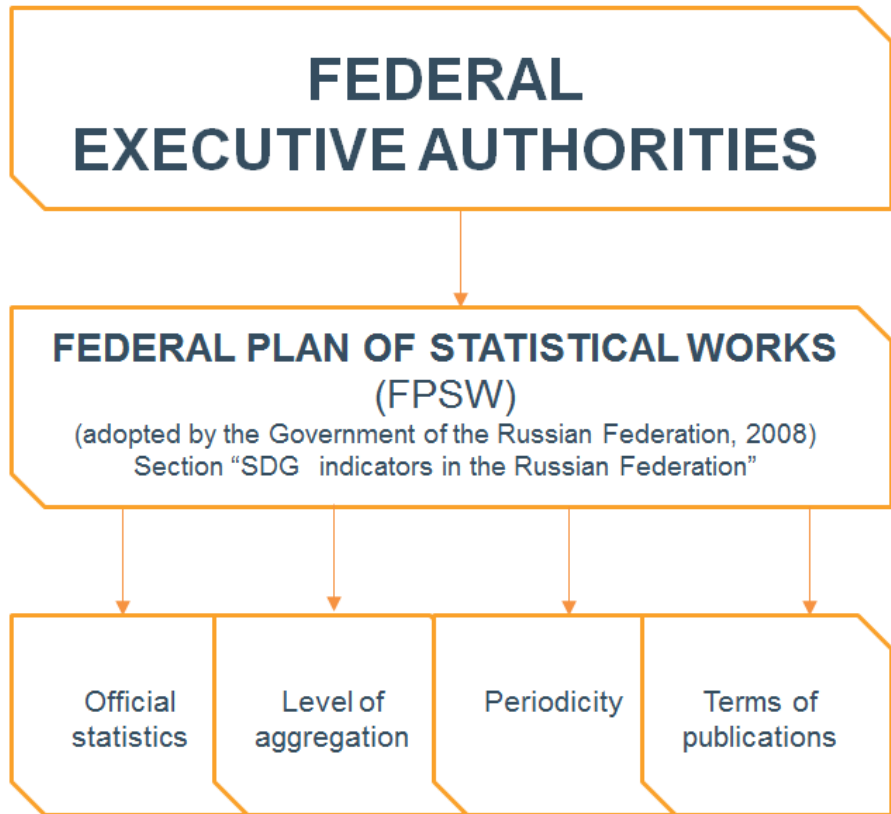

Rosstat is authorized to coordinate the activities of the federal authorities on the collection and submission of official statistical information on SDG indicators to the international organizations

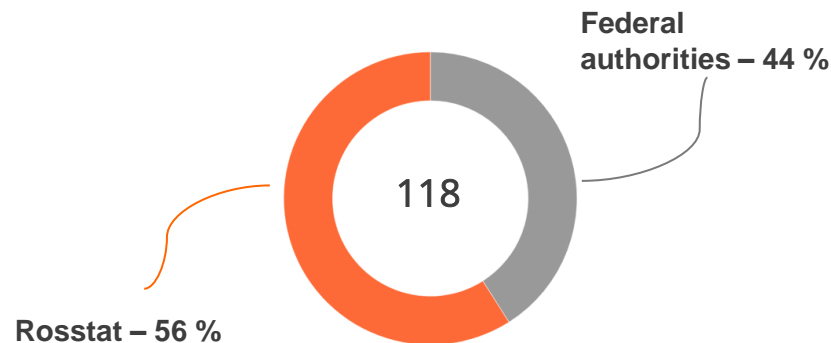
Federal plan of statistical works (Federal plan) determines the order of the submission of official statistical information on SDG indicators to the international organizations

Section 2.8 "SDG indicators in the Russian Federation" is included in Federal Plan of Statistical Works

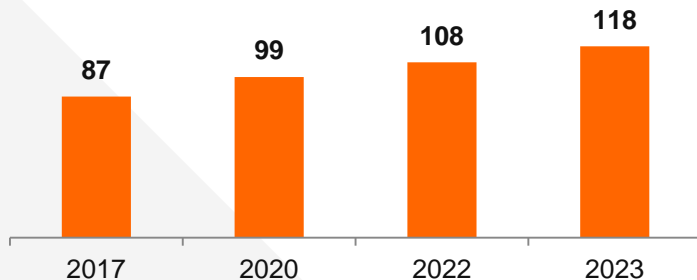
GLOBAL SDG INDICATORS



Rosstat and 25 federal authorities provide data on global SDGs

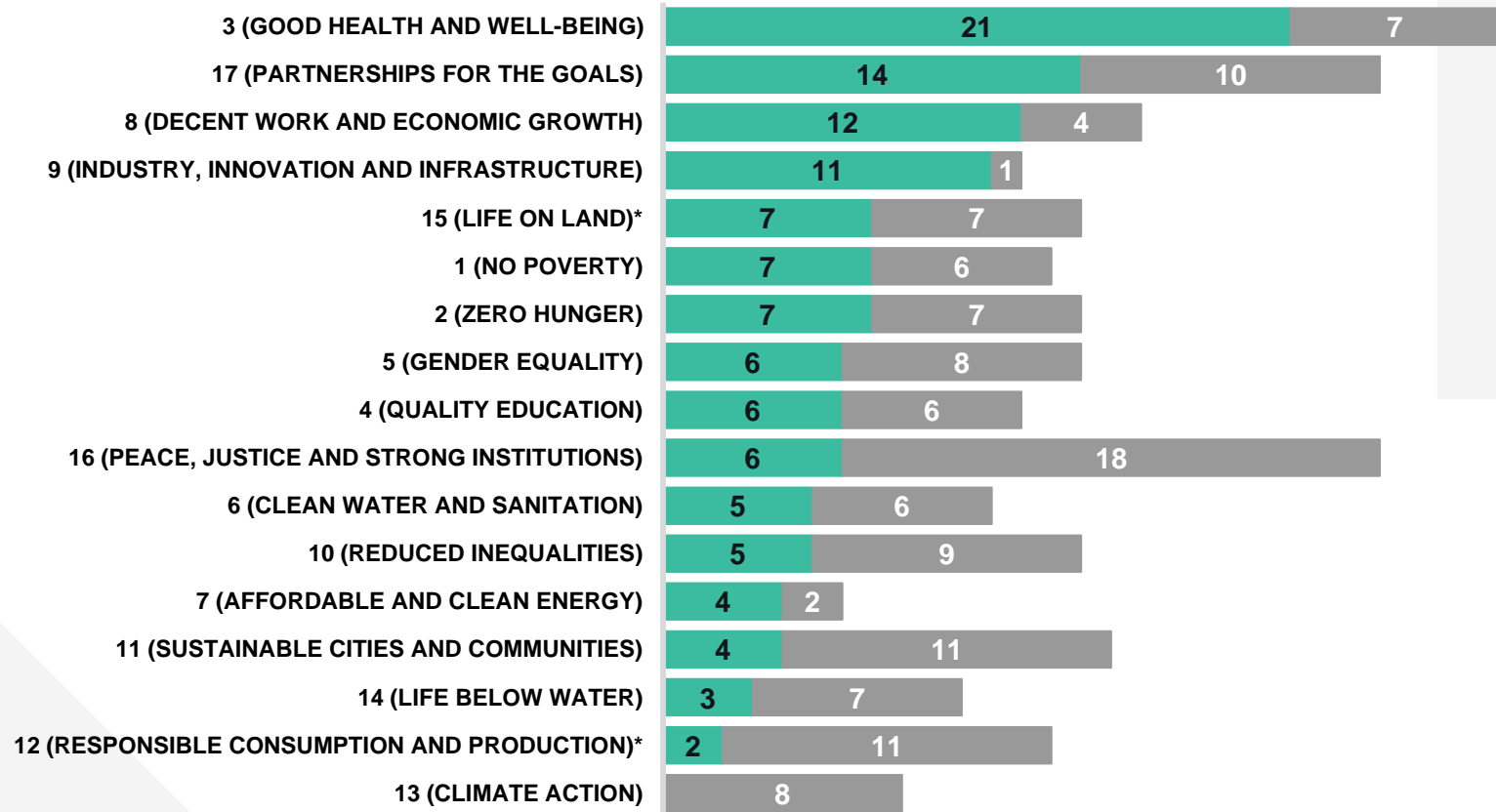

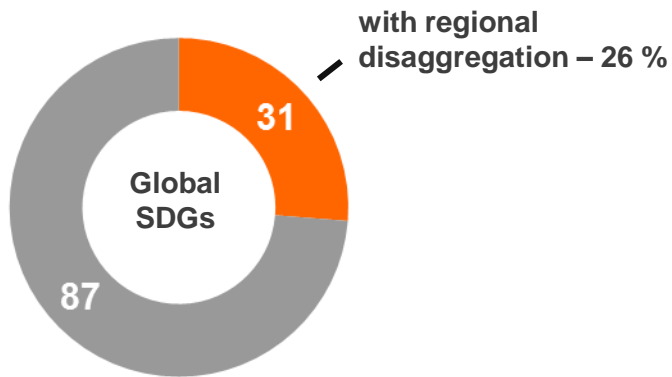

GLOBAL SDGS IN THE REGIONS OF RUSSIA



2023: total 118



87 (74%) global SDGs aren't disaggregated by regions:

- ✓ for **6 indicators** regional data can be provided
- ✓ data for **31 indicators** can be developed only at the country level (according to international metadata)
- ✓ data for **1 indicator** is available only for certain cities
- ✓ **14 indicators** are based on survey results (sample sizes are insufficient for regional disaggregation)
- ✓ **5 indicators** are non-statistical
- ✓ **30 indicators** require further methodological elaboration with relevant authorities

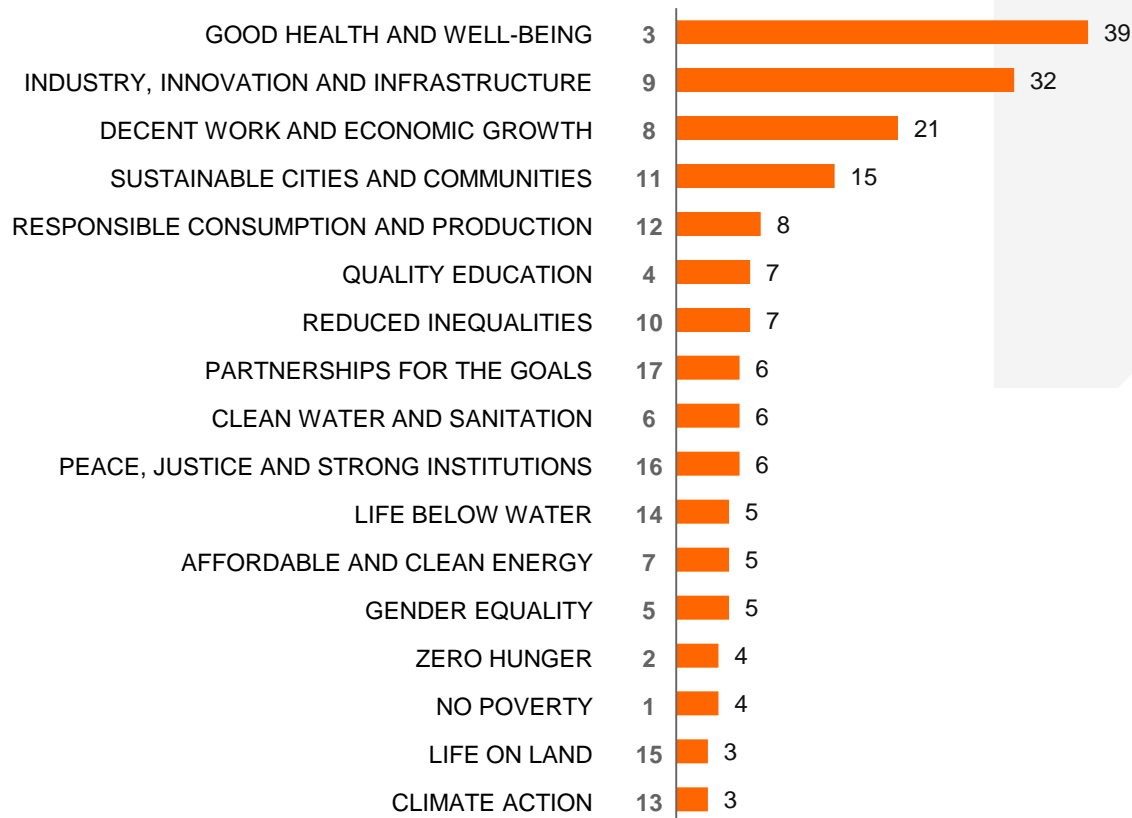

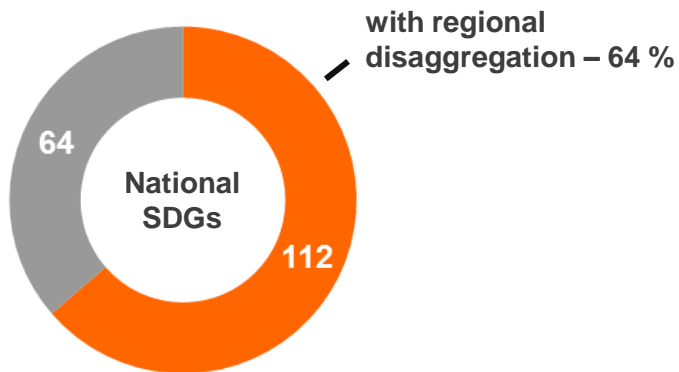

- ✓ for **17 indicators** the FPSW doesn't include regional disaggregation
- ✓ **7 indicators** require further methodological elaboration with relevant authorities

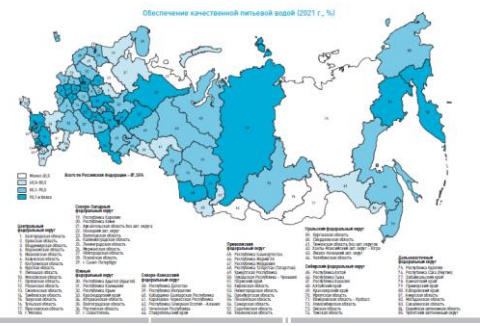
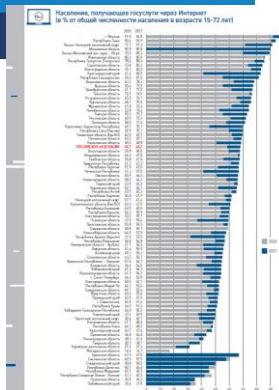
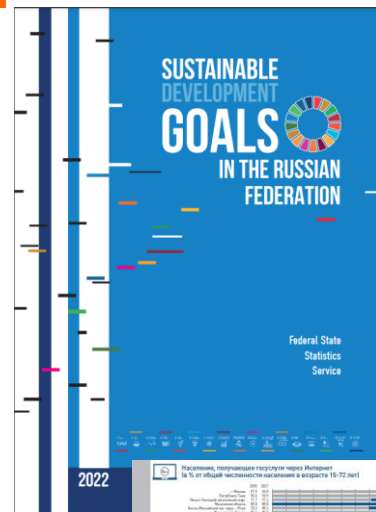
