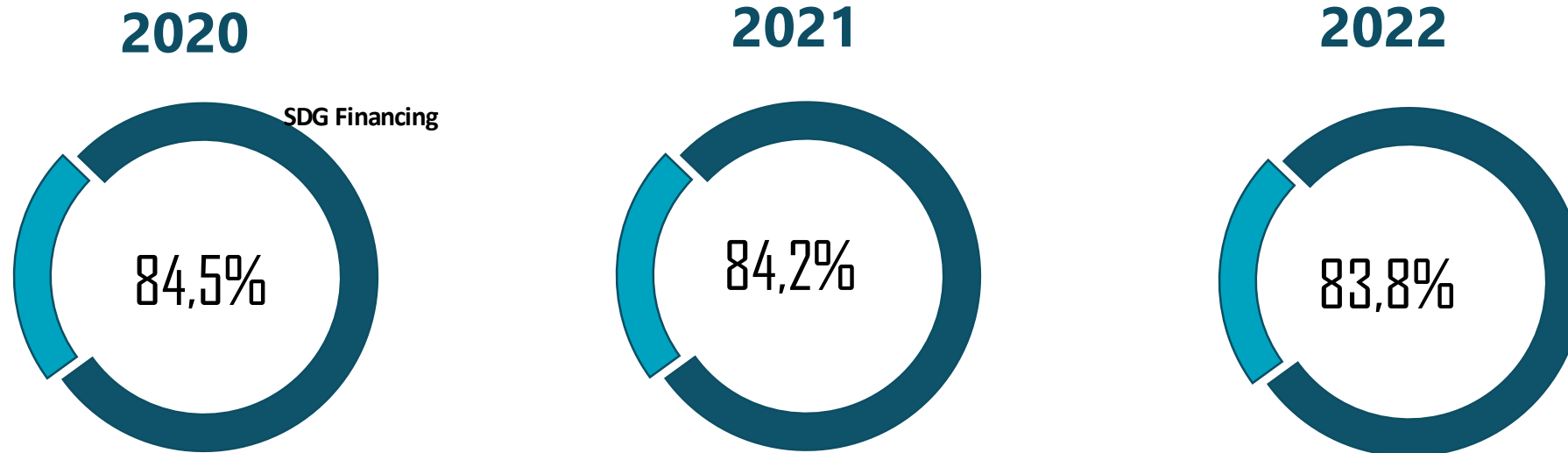

- Coverage of SDG targets – **20 to 97** targets (12% to 57%)
- A number of SDG targets are not taken into account because they are not relevant or they are not within the competence of a region

Monitoring of SDG Indicators



118 of **231** global indicators are included in Federal statistical work plan



National list of SDG indicators consist of **176** indicators, **47** of them are global indicators



112 indicators from the National list of SDG indicators are disaggregated to the regional level



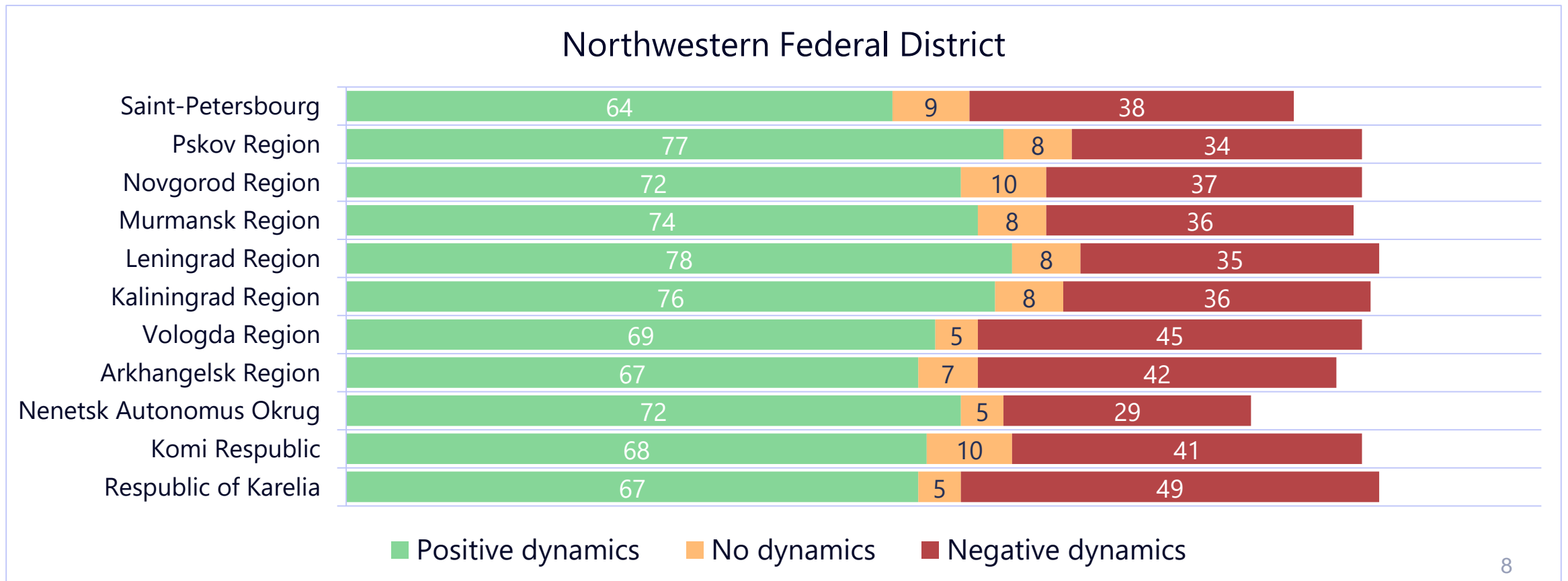
There are practices of monitoring **additional** indicators in the regions



Indicators of **SDG 14: Life Below Water** and **SDG 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions** aren't disaggregated to the regional level

Dynamics of SDG Indicators

- The total number of observed indicators ranges from **106** to **122**
- There is a positive dynamics for **69%** of the indicators in more than a half of the regions of the Russian Federation



Dynamics of SDG Indicators



- **SDG 4: Quality Education** - the largest share of indicators with positive dynamics from 2018 to 2021
- **SDG 3: Good Health and Well-Being** - the largest share of indicators with negative dynamics from 2018 to 2021. Represents longstanding consequences of COVID-19

Stakeholders Cooperation

- Inter-agency cooperation between federal and regional authorities on the achievement of the SDGs is carried out through regional projects and programs
- Government, business, expert community and general public fragmentary contribute to the implementation of the SDGs
- Business proactively publish ESG reports

Expert Interviews

- More than **50** expert interviews with stakeholders: regional authorities, business, scientific and educational centers, public associations
- Analysis of the perception of the Sustainable Development Goals and ESG principles in regions
- Analysis of the relevance, prospects and problems of the implementation of national and global goals in regions

Recommendations

- on organizing a system for monitoring and controlling the achievement of SDG indicators and determining planned values for the regions of the Russian Federation
- on measures aimed at raising awareness and increasing engagement of all stakeholders in the SDG implementation (including non-financial reporting)
- on developing and distributing a register of best regional practices of the SDG implementation
- on expanding the list of national SDG indicators, including those disaggregated to the regional level

SDG Audit Approaches

INTOSAI WG on SDG and Key Sustainable Development Indicators

- Established in 2019 to support the INTOSAI community's efforts to achieve the SDGs
- 36 members and 7 observers

- ✓ include basic concepts, approaches and principles



SDG Audit at the Regional Level

Adapted INTOSAI seven-step assessment model



- 1 Correlation between the Sustainable Development (SD) Agenda and the regional strategic planning documents
- 2 Integration assessment of the SD principles into laws and regulations
- 3 Assessment of interinstitutional and stakeholder cooperation
- 4 Assessment of the SD data openness
- 5 Assessment of the monitoring system
- 6 Progress assessment towards the goals indicators
- 7 Assessment of funding of the activities related to the SDGs implementation

Guidance on ESG Audit



- Auditing national governments measures aimed at stimulating responsible business conduct
- Auditing ESG reporting of public sector organizations
- Auditing ESG reporting in international organizations
